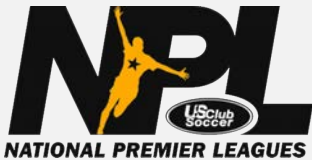
# ELITE NATIONAL PREMIER LEAGUE

- Features NPL member leagues and ECNL Boys Conference



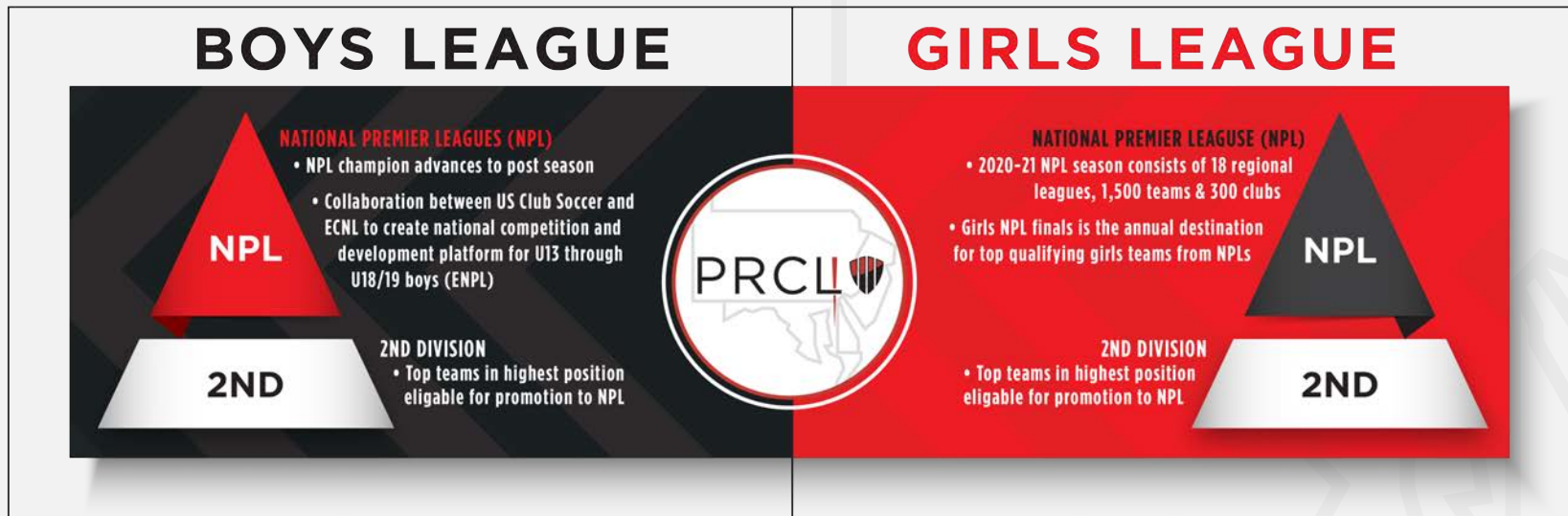
# NATIONAL PREMIER LEAGUES

# LEAGUE COSTS

---

- U9-U12: \$450 (Annually)
- U13-U19: \$700 (Annually)

*\*Percentage of fees will be reinvested into PDP and coaching education*

## **PASS FEES PAID DIRECTLY TO US CLUB SOCCER (BY YOUR CLUB)**

- \$18 per player (U11 and below, yearly)
- \$24 per player (U12 through U19, yearly)
- \$25 per coach (2 year pass)
- \$10 per recreational player fee (yearly)
